## this week: chfa's housing continuum white paper

CHFA recently published a white paper focused on Colorado's housing continuum. A housing continuum shows the range of available housing options in a community, from short-term shelters for those experiencing homelessness to affordable rental housing to homeownership opportunities.

Included in the white paper is information about Area Median Income (AMI) and employment wages needed to afford housing in Colorado, data indicating how many Coloradans comprise the various segments of the continuum, as well as how CHFA's programs and investments support housing across the continuum.
