In 2023, CHFA spearheaded the development of the Colorado Multifamily Affordable Housing Electrification Hub, a building electrification resource for developers of affordable multifamily housing. This website supports Colorado's Renewable Energy and Climate Action Goals, providing developers with technical resources, case studies, and an interactive database of funding and incentive opportunities.

The Hub was built in partnership with a steering committee of industry experts including the Division of Housing (DOH), the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT), Colorado Energy Office (CEO), Energy Outreach Colorado, Group 14 Engineering, and Enterprise Community Partners.
