The Authority has received a letter from the Internal Revenue Service, dated March 10, 2006, a copy of which is attached.

The letter reports that the IRS has selected the above-referenced issue (the “Bonds”) for examination, and that the IRS routinely examines municipal debt issuances to determine compliance with Federal tax requirements. The letter asks for copies of specified documents and responses to specific questions, and provides that other items may be requested as the examination proceeds.

The Authority is cooperating with the IRS in its examination of the Bonds. The Authority has advised Republic Services, Inc. (the “Company”) of receipt of the IRS letter, and the Company has advised the Authority that it is cooperating with the IRS.
