homebuyer education update: framework no longer accepted

As of January 1, 2021, CHFA **will no longer accept Framework** as an online homebuyer education platform.

- CHFA will accept certificates from individuals who completed the Framework online course via one of our homebuyer education providers on or before December 31, 2020.
- These users will have until January 31, 2021, to complete the follow-up call and receive a valid certificate.
- Certificates issued by our approved providers on or before January 31, 2021, are valid for 12 months. Certificates dated after this time will not be accepted.
