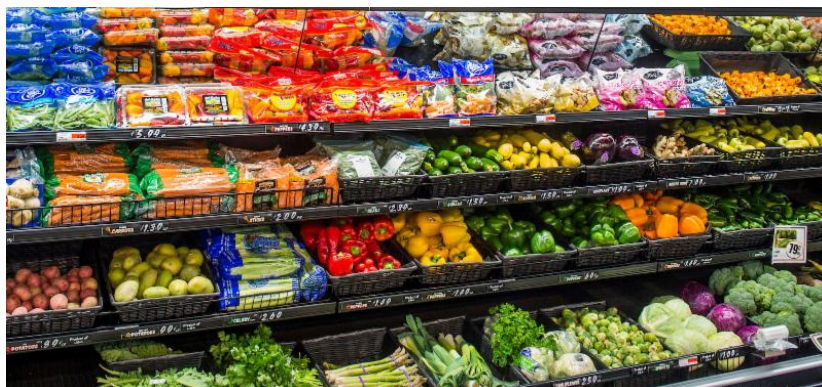

According to Clínica, Leever is an invaluable community partner that has supported its special events and healthy cooking classes. In addition, its new Save-A-Lot store in Montbello provides space for Clínica to offer yoga and diabetes prevention classes to patients and community residents.

Earlier this year, CO4F helped bring the Montbello Save-A-Lot location to life with a \$1.5 million loan. Other CO4F partners, Colorado Enterprise Fund and The Colorado Trust, invested \$1 million each to support the Montbello Save-A-Lot.

Save-A-Lot offers a 600 square-foot community room that features a full demonstration kitchen where it hosts cooking and health classes, and other local events. The space is available to the
