The Colorado Affordable Housing Developer's Guide was designed to support local for-profit and nonprofit developers, community leaders, and advocates seeking to ensure that safe, decent, and affordable housing is an intentional and integrated part of their community fabric. CHFA developed and published the Guide in partnership with Enterprise Community Partners, Colorado Division of Housing (DOH), and an array of focus group and survey participants.

Specific topics covered in the Guide include housing development models, team structure and roles, community engagement, predevelopment, market feasibility, financial feasibility, project construction, operations and compliance, and a variety of tools and resources. The Guide is dedicated to all Coloradans who are seeking housing stability and economic prosperity.
