CHFA helps business owners access the capital they need to grow and create jobs.

Using a variety of resources, such as bonds, New Markets Tax Credits, and revolving loan funds, CHFA leverages greater investment in our state. This includes partnering with lenders and economic development professionals to ensure that resources meet Colorado's unique needs while supporting established community relationships.

In 2023, CHFA's business finance investments totaled more than \$120 million—the highest one-year total in CHFA's history impacting more than 3,000 jobs across the state. CHFA also received an award of \$65 million in federal New Markets Tax Credits (NMTCs) in 2023, the highest award amount allocated to qualified applicants and the largest allocation in CHFA's history.
