The undersigned, as an essential part of the application for the Reissued Mortgage Credit Certificate, hereby swears (or affirms) that:

- 1. The property described in the address above is the same one for which I was originally issued a CHFA Statewide Mortgage Credit Certificate (CHFA MCC) and is my principal residence.
- 2. The CHFA MCC has not been revoked.
- 3. Except only for reason of death or divorce, I am the same person to whom the original CHFA MCC was issued.
- 4. I have refinanced my mortgage one or more times and am requesting that my CHFA MCC be reissued for the lesser of the new mortgage indebtedness or the remaining outstanding balance of the certified mortgage indebtedness (the "Certified Indebtedness Amount") specified on the existing MCC.
- 5. I understand that the reissued certificate will not result in an increase in the tax credit that would otherwise have been allowable to me under the existing MCC for any taxable year.
