this week: direct effect awards

CHFA's Direct Effect Awards recognize Colorado nonprofit organizations whose missions align with CHFA's work to strengthen Colorado by investing in affordable housing and community development. Eligible recipients include nonprofit and not-for-profit organizations including public housing authorities, cities, counties, and local municipalities.

CHFA has donated more than \$5.6 million in Direct Effect Awards to more than 370 Colorado organizations since 2021, with an average donation amount of \$11,304.

Applications for Round One of 2024 Direct Effect Awards open April 1st and close April 26th. Awardees will be notified in late July. This year, to commemorate 50 years of strengthening Colorado, up to five \$50,000 donations will be awarded during each round.
