April is Fair Housing Month, commemorating the passage of the Fair Housing Act signed into law on April 11, 1968, by President Lyndon B. Johnson. This landmark federal legislation prohibits housing discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability, and familial status.

CHFA is committed to providing educational resources for property owners, managers and residents on fair housing and an array of other topics through the chfareach program, an acronym which stands for "Research, Education and Assistance for Colorado Housing." The chfareach curriculum features courses taught by subject matter experts, including affordable housing developers and legal professionals.
